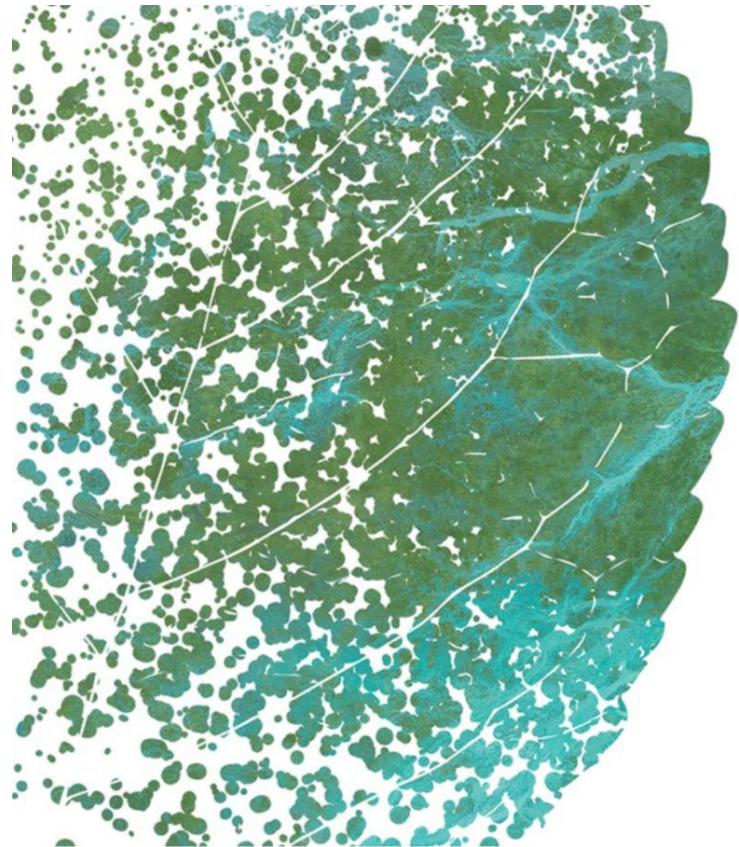

She has been painting for much of her life, and has been a professional artist since earning a degree from Emily Carr University of Art and Design in 2003. Her work has earned her well-deserved attention around Canada and Internationally, including displays in the Madrona Gallery in Victoria and Mountain Galleries at the Fairmont Hotels in Whistler, Banff, Jasper and Stratford. Wolcoski is an advocate and friend of the planet and the common good, as expressed through her partnership with the Nature Conservancy.
